#### Where is American Samoa located?

American Samoa, unincorporated territory of the United States consisting of the eastern part of the Samoan archipelago, located in the south-central Pacific Ocean. The capital, Pago Pago, was a strategic naval base for the U.S. military (1900-51) but now serves as a commercial port of call.

#### How tall is American Samoa?

It is 966 m (3,169 ft)tall. The lowest point is the Pacific Ocean (0m). At the extremities of the islands,coral reefs are common. American Samoa is administratively divided into 3 districts and 2 islands (unorganized atolls).

### Are there more American Samoans abroad than on the islands?

Additionally, since the mid-20th century many American Samoans have migrated to the United States, with the result that there are more American Samoans abroad than on the islands. The population that remains in American Samoa is concentrated in urban areas; only about one-eighth is rural.

### What ethnicity is American Samoa?

American Samoa is small enough to have just one ZIP code,96799,and uses the U.S. Postal Service (state code "AS") for mail delivery. In the 2020 census,89.4% of the population reported at least partial Samoanethnicity,83.2% only Samoan,5.8% Asian,5.5% other Pacific island ethnicities,4.4% mixed,and 1.1% other ethnicities.

### Is American Samoa a US citizen?

People who are born in American Samoa are called U.S. nationals, not U.S. citizens. This means they have some of the same rights as citizens but not all of them. Unlike people who are not Americans at all, American Samoans can go to any other part of the United States they want and live there for as long as they want.

### Who is American Samoa famous for?

Boxing: Maselino Masoe, who represented American Samoa in three consecutive Olympics from 1988 to 1996, was WBA middleweight champion from 2004 to 2006. Professional wrestling: Several American Samoan athletes have been very visible in professional wrestling. The Anoa?i family in particular has had many of its members employed by WWE.
