



In September 2019, it was announced that Babcock had been selected as the preferred bidder to build the new fleet of five Type 31 frigates for the Royal Navy. During 2018 and 2019, Babcock rebuffed multiple unsolicited advances by public services provider Serco to merge the two businesses together.

On 1 March 2024, Babcock signed a £560 million contract to refit the submarine, HMS Victorious at Devonport, securing over 1,000 jobs and extending its service life into the 2030s.
