The new terrestrial protected area covers a total of 3,800 square kilometers and complements the marine protected area of 1.24 million square kilometers that has been in place since 2012, meaning that the entire water and land area of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is now under one protected area system.

Together, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands form part of the Scotia Arc, which extends from the tip of South America to Antarctica (and also includes the South Shetland and South Orkney Islands, though these are not part of the British dependency). The island of South Georgia is 105 mi (170 km) long, and about 25 mi (40 km) wide.

The Antarctic Treaty of 1962 resulted in a separation of the British Antarctic Territory from the UK Dependencies. South Georgia then received its first stamps. In 1985 the Falkland Islands ...
