# Chile energy storage springs



### How many energy storage projects are in Chile?

Currently,36of the 129 large-scale projects Latin America projects with an energy storage component under development are in Chile,including 32 out of 71 of the region's early works projects. The storage technologies either in use or being considered include:

### How much battery storage capacity does Chile have?

According to data from Acera, the Chilean Renewable Energy Association, there are only 64MW of battery storage capacity currently active, representing 0.2% of national capacity. AES Andes, a subsidiary of U.S. company AES Corp. operates all 64MW at their Angamos and Los Andes substations.

Are battery energy storage systems a viable alternative for Chilean power producers?

With transmission lines at overcapacity and permitting delays slowing the development of new grid infrastructure, battery energy storage systems (BESS) have surged as a profitable alternative for Chilean power producers.

What kind of energy does Chile use?

Chile has the potential to run exclusively on renewable generation, with an estimated energy mix of 46% solar, 31% wind, 12% hydroelectric, and 8% flexible natural gas power plants, as well as 23% of battery storage capacity. The remaining 2% is split between biomass, geothermal, and other less common energy sources.

How many Bess projects are there in Chile?

This momentum is reflected in the data: AMI estimates that there is a 7.7 GWpipeline of BESS projects in Chile, far and away the most advanced front of the meter (FTM) storage market in Latin America. 1 Only 505 MW of BESS projects are currently operational in the entire region.

### How long does a battery last in Chile?

Moreover, the lack of an ancillary services market in Chile discourages shorter duration batteries (1-2 hours) as seen in the US and Europe. The general industry consensus is to maximize the availability of the battery and focus on 2-3 revenue streams instead of 4 to 5 (e.g., energy arbitrage, capacity payment, and frequency reserve).

The project, which was revealed by Grenergy in November 2023, will pair 1GW of solar PV with 4.1GWh of energy storage, which the company said makes it the largest energy storage projects in the world. "The ...

Large scale battery storage on the rise in Chile Three utility scale battery energy storage projects collocated with solar plants were announced last week in Chile. Enel is building a 67 MW/134 MWh battery, while CJR Renewable and Uriel Renovables are planning 200 MW/800 MWh and 90 MW/200 MWh projects, respectively.

According to its Strategic Plan 2023-2026, the IPP will commit US\$2.6 billion to these expansions, with US\$1.5 billion allocated to solar PV and US\$800 million to energy storage. Of its three major operational markets - the US, Europe and Latin America - Grenergy highlighted Chile as a fulcrum for leveraging up its solar and storage businesses.



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Recognition of capacity payment for pure or "stand-alone" storage, i.e. those storage facilities not associated with generation plants. A transitional rule is established to promote storage and ensure that storage units are recognized as having sufficient capacity for a period of ten years, thus favoring those systems having more time of storage, as follows:
