

What is Cocos Keeling Island?

What is it? The Cocos Keeling Islands are an atoll of 27 small islands, with only two inhabited by people - West Island and Home Island. Outside of those two there are 25 others just waiting to be discovered, including the tiny Prison Island and Direction Island - home to Cossie's Beach - crowned the Best Beach in Australia in 2017.

How many islands are there in Cocos Keeling?

A place where time seems to slow down with idyllic natural surrounds and friendly locals who love to host. Of the 27 islands, just two are inhabited - West Island and Home Island. The rest are waiting to be explored. The Cocos Keeling Islands have a total population of 600 people, including around 450 Cocos Malay.

How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI - Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two - West Island and Home Island - are inhabited.
