What is Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

Cocos (Keeling) Islands is a non-self governing territory of Australia, administered by the Australian Department of Transport and Regional Services (DOTARS). The legal system is under the authority of the Governor General of Australia and Australian law.

Are there signs on Cocos Islands?

Sign boards on the island also feature Malay translations. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands consist of two flat,low-lying coral atolls with an area of 14.2 square kilometres (5.5 sq mi),26 kilometres (16 mi) of coastline,a highest elevation of 5 metres (16 ft) and thickly covered with coconut palms and other vegetation.

Does Australia respect the Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

The Australian Government also gave a commitment to respect the traditions, cultures and religious beliefs of the people of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands. How do the Cocos (Keeling) Islands communicate?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have access to a range of modern communication services. Digital television stations are broadcast from Western Australia via satellite. A local radio station, 6CKI - Voice of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, is staffed by community volunteers and provides some local content.

What is the Cocos (Keeling) Islands Act 1955?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands Act 1955,administered by the Australian Federal Government's Department of Transport and Regional Services on behalf of the Minister for Local Government,Territories and Roads,provides the legislative basis for the Territory's administrative,legislative and judicial system.

It is available in paper and electronic formats. The Cocos (Keeling) Islands receives a range of digital channels from Western Australia via satellite and is broadcast from the Airport Buildingon the West Island on the following VHF frequencies: ABC6,SBS7,WAW8,WOW10 and WDW11
