How to optimize solar generation in Tallinn Estonia?

Assuming you can modify the tilt angle of your solar PV panels throughout the year, you can optimize your solar generation in Tallinn, Estonia as follows: In Summer, set the angle of your panels to 42°; facing South. In Autumn, tilt panels to 61°; facing South for maximum generation.

Is Estonia a good country for solar PV?

Estonia ranks 58th in the world for cumulative solar PV capacity, with 414 total MW's of solar PV installed. Each year Estonia is generating 311 Watts from solar PV per capita (Estonia ranks 13th in the world for solar PV Watts generated per capita). [source]

How much solar radiation does Estonia produce a year?

In Estonia, the amount of solar radiation is comparable to Central Europe; the average amount of radiation has an optimal slope and azimuth of 1100-1200 kWh/m<sup>2</sup>, 85% of which falls between April and October. An optimally installed 1 kW PV plant produces 900 to 1000 kWh of energy per year.

How much solar power does Tallinn produce a day?

Tallinn, Harjuma, Estonia (latitude: 59.433, longitude: 24.7323) offers varying potential for solar power generation throughout the year. The average energy production per day per kW of installed solar capacity in each season is as follows: 5.99 kWh/day in Summer, 1.54 kWh/day in Autumn, 0.50 kWh/day in Winter, and 3.97 kWh/day in Spring.
