Are solar panels a viable source of electricity in Eswatini?

Photovoltaic (PV) solar cells are increasingly prominent sources of small-scale electricity production in Eswatini. The government actively encourages the adoption of solar panels in residential and commercial buildings to provide both electricity and water heating.

Image credit: AFP Frazium Energy - part of the Australian-German Frazer Solar group - has signed a 40-year contract with the government of the Southern African kingdom of Eswatini (formerly known as Swaziland) for a EUR100 million (\$115 million) solar battery project.

The photovoltaic solar cells will emit the sunlight and convert the gathered solar energy into power energy, which is then stored in the solar battery. At night, the lamp will switch on automatically then consumes the solar power that is stored in the battery. During the first 5 hours of the night, the light will work at average lumens brightness.

Frazium Energy has entered into a EUR100 million contract with the government of the Southern African kingdom of Eswatini for a solar battery project. The contract has been entered for a period of 40 years. With an initial capacity of 100 MW, the project will be located at the Edwaleni Power Station in the town of Matsapha. ...

Frazium Energy has signed a contract with the Eswatini government to develop a solar PV and storage project. The first phase is expected to consist of a 25-30MW solar PV component with a 100MW lithium-ion battery, supplying about 100GWh/yr at a cost of \$115m, according to chief executive Robert Frazer.
