

Installing solar power on the roof without permission

Can I install solar panels without planning permission?

If you live in a house with permitted development rights you can install solar panels without planning permission, subject to certain conditions and limitations. These rights may vary based on location and property type, so you must check with your local planning authority.

Do I need planning permission to install roof panels?

There are a few conditions that apply if the requirement for planning permission is to be avoided. Panels must not be installed above the ridgeline of the property and should not protrude more than 200mm from the surface of your roof.

How do I apply for a solar panel installation?

Local Planning Authority: Applications should be directed to the local planning authority. Supporting Documents: Detailed site plans, elevations, and full specifications of the panels will be necessary. Compliance with planning permissions and building regulations is crucial for a lawful solar panel installation.

Can you put solar panels on a building?

Yes, if the installation falls under permitted development. However, if you live in a conservation area or world heritage site you can't put solar panels on the principal or side elevation walls of your house if it fronts a highway. This would require a planning application. Are there restrictions for solar panels on a listed building?
