What is the meaning of the name Bess?

The name Bess is of Greek origin, and its meaning is either 'oath of God' or 'God is satisfaction'. (From the Hebrew Elisheba)

Is Bess a Hebrew name?

The root Hebrew words for this name are 'El,' meaning 'God,' and 'shava,' meaning 'oath.' Thus, the meaning of Bess can be considered to be 'God's oath' or 'God is my oath.' The name is pronounced BES, and a notable spelling variant is Bez. Cognate names include Bessie, Bessi, Betty, Beth, and Betsy, all of which trace their origins to Elizabeth.
