

How to install solar panels?

How does a solar panel installation work?

The installer will have to lift some of the roof tiles to fix the anchors to the rafters in the loft. This will give the solar panel mounts a stable foundation, and will make sure they don't get damaged in stormy weather. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.

How do I design a solar PV system?

When designing a solar PV system, there are a number of important factors to consider: Orientation - the direction the system will face (e.g. south, east/west). For existing buildings with sloping roofs, this is clearly fixed and will influence the viability of installing solar (north-facing is not worthwhile in the UK).

Do you need a survey to install a solar panel?

So first, a professional surveyor will check your roof and rafters to ensure that a solar panel installation can go ahead safely. The results of the survey may affect the price quoted by your solar panel providers. With that done, the installation can begin.

How much does it cost to install solar panels?
