

What is the Puerto Rico energy resilience fund (PR-ERF)?

In December 2022, President Biden authorized \$1 billion for the establishment of the Puerto Rico Energy Resilience Fund (PR-ERF), which is administered by DOE's Grid Deployment Office. The PR-ERF is a separate federal funding source to drive key investments in renewable and resilient energy infrastructure in Puerto Rico.

What does PR-ERF funding mean for Puerto Rico?

The first tranche of PR-ERF funding, up to \$440 million, will help lower energy bills for 30,000-40,000 single-family households in Puerto Rico, improve household energy resilience, and keep the lights on during extreme weather events.

How will Puerto Rico benefit from a solar PV project?

Annually, the solar PV installations will produce approximately 460,000 MWh of energy, enough to power approximately 43,000 homes, and enhance Puerto Rico's grid reliability and energy security. The co-location of the new solar and battery resources will help maximize the project's energy production and improve grid stability.

How much money does Puerto Rico have to pay for solar?

Up to \$190 million is available to Puerto Rico's Housing Administration and a private company to pay for solar and battery installations in public housing common areas and subsidized, multifamily housing properties. Another \$175 million is available for certain healthcare and dialysis centers.

Does Puerto Rico have a high energy cost?

Puerto Rican residents pay energy costs significantly higher than the U.S. average. According to the Climate and Economic Justice Screening Tool, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, including the communities surrounding the Salinas and Jobos projects, faces some of the greatest energy burdens in the United States.
