Central and South Eastern Europe is a region which has historically relied on fossil fuels for most of its energy needs.

Who will benefit from rezolv?

This will include supermarkets, breweries, telecoms and other large businesses. Rezolv aims to build a multi-gigawatt portfolio of wind, solar and energy storage. This will help companies and countries across the region meet their energy needs in response to energy security challenges and climate policies.

Will rezolv be able to build a wind power plant?

At launch, Rezolv has signed agreements to acquire development rights to two wind projects in the Central and South Eastern Europe region, with a combined capacity of 1GW. Construction contracts are expected to be awarded early next year, with the projects expected to be operational by 2025-26.

The construction works on the project will begin by June 2023, and the solar power plant should enter commercial operation in 2025 when it is planned to cover the energy needs of some 1 million people. In August, Rezolv Energy signed similar agreements for the development of two wind projects in Romania with a combined capacity of 1 GW.
