Power Grid Corporation of India, International Finance Corporation and World Bank reached an in-principle agreement to fund the project. Supported by a 400MW power purchase agreement (PPA) with Madhya Pradesh Power Management Company, the solar energy project is expected to come online by 2023.

Ocean Sun, a company based in Norway, and EN Technologies, a company based in South Korea, reached a deal for the deployment of the former's systems at the Saemangeum floating solar project, in July 2020. Approximately 0.5GW of the total capacity will be developed by private companies.

Where is the British Overseas Territories (BOT) located?

The BIOT is one of 14 British Overseas Territories. Located in the Indian Ocean, it is made up of the Chagos Archipelago of islands, including the biggest island, Diego Garcia, the site of a joint US-UK military base.

The largest and southernmost of the 58 islands, Diego Garcia, contains a joint UK-US naval support facility.

The territory is a small, remote area of land and water, with a population of around 100 people. It is a unique and important part of the United Kingdom's global presence.

On Thursday 3 October, my right honourable and learned friend the Prime Minister and Mauritian Prime Minister Jugnauth made an historic announcement: after two years of negotiations and decades of disagreement, the United Kingdom and Mauritius have reached a political agreement on the future of the British Indian Ocean Territory.
