Will Mozambique get a solar power plant in 2023?

How much does a solar system cost in Mozambique?

Will Mozambique achieve universal energy access by 2030?

By 2030, the Government of Mozambique hopes to transform this landscape, and achieve universal energy access by the end of the decade. Who won a solar power plant in Mozambique?

The first tender under the programme was the Dondo solar power plant which was won by Independent Power Producer (IPP), Total Eren (now acquired by Total Energies), with a tariff of \$52.45/MWh, and is supported by Electricidade de Mozambique (EDM) and the French Development Agency (AFD).
