

Who owns State Grid?

As of March 2024, State Grid is the world's third largest company overall by revenue, behind Walmart and Amazon. In 2023 it was reported as having 1.3 million employees, 1.1 billion customers and revenue equivalent to US\$546 billion. It is overseen by the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council.

How much power does China's State Grid generate a year?

Will state grid build a stable and economical power transmission channel?

State Grid said it will build a stable, safe and economical power transmission channel to further absorb more clean energy, based on complementary multi-energy mix of hydropower, wind power and photovoltaic in the country, said Xin Baoan, executive chairman of the Beijing-based central State-owned enterprise.

Does state Grid have clean power?

State Grid has made major strides in clean power. As the dominant electricity distributor in the world's biggest energy consumption market, the company kicked off three pumped hydro storage plants in Shanxi, Zhejiang and Shandong provinces in December, to ease idled solar and wind power capacity.

When was the State Grid Corporation of China founded?

The State Grid Corporation of China was founded on December 29, 2002, when the restructuring divided the former State Power Corporation of China into two grid companies, five generation groups and four accessorial business companies.

What is the energy utilization rate of State Grid?

So far, the new energy utilization rate of State Grid's operating projects is around 97 percent. The company will also further enhance the trans-province clean energy power transmission, advancing consumption of clean energy and promoting electric power by innovating environmental protective power grid technology, said Xin.
