What are the environmental effects of PV solar energy?

Compared with fossil-based electrical power system, PV solar energy has significantly lower pollutants and greenhouse gases (GHG) emissions. However, PV solar technology are not free of adverse environmental consequences such as biodiversity and habitat loss, climatic effects, resource consumption, and disposal of massive end-of-life PV panels.

Are PV panels harmful to the environment?

The disposal of chemical components used in the production of PV panels such as arsenic, cadmium telluride, chromium and lead, at the end of their lifetime is a potential threat to the environment. Also, many greenhouse gases such as CO₂ are generated due to fossil fuels used in panel production process.

Are solar panels harmful to the environment?

The production of solar panels requires the extraction of materials like silicon, silver, and aluminum. The mining and processing of these materials pose significant environmental consequences, including habitat destruction, soil erosion, water pollution, and greenhouse gas emissions.
