How long can a refrigerator keep food safe during a power outage?

As the USDA notes in Keeping Food Safe During an Emergency, your refrigerator will keep food safe for up to 4 hours during a power outage. Keep the door closed as much as possible. Discard refrigerated perishable food such as meat, poultry, fish, eggs, and leftovers after 4 hours without power.

How long can you keep food in the fridge without power?

We have trusted food safety tips so you know what you can keep and what you definitely need to ditch from your fridge. How long will food be OK in the fridge without power? If the doors stay closed, the CDC says the food in the fridge will be okay to eat for up to four hours. Try to open the refrigerator as little as possible.

How long can you keep food in a fridge after a power cut?

Relatives, friends or neighbours may be able to provide alternative storage. Your food will remain safe in your refrigerator for 2 hours. If it has been more than 4 hours, throw the food out. Don't open the fridge door during the power cut, unless necessary.

Can You refreeze food if the power goes out?

If the food still contains ice crystals or is 40°F or below, it is safe to refreeze or cook. Refrigerated food should be safe as long as the power was out for no more than 4 hours. Keep the door closed as much as possible. Discard any perishable food (such as meat, poultry, fish, eggs or leftovers) that has been above 40°F for two hours or more.

How long can you keep food in the fridge if doors are closed?

If the doors stay closed, the CDC says the food in the fridge will be okay to eat for up to four hours. Try to open the refrigerator as little as possible. This will keep the temperature inside colder for longer.

How long does a refrigerator stay cold after a power outage?

The Food and Drug Administration says a refrigerator will stay cold for up to four hours, while a freezer will keep its temperature for 48 hours if it is full, 24 hours if it is half-full. The American Red Cross recommends using coolers if the power outage is expected to go beyond a day.
