

What is a roof mounted photovoltaic system guidance?

The guidance refers only to the mechanical installation of roof mounted integrated and stand-off photovoltaic systems; it provides best practice guidance on installation requirements and does not constitute fixing instructions.

What is a fully integrated photovoltaic roof?

Figure 1. Fully integrated photovoltaic (PV) roof "RIS." The solutions that have been proven fall into the following categories: Interlocking panel systems, which either use panels that mimic roofing tiles with the photovoltaic (PV) element embedded in the surface or have a frame bonded to the PV panel which provides the sealing interlock.

How much weight can a solar roof hold?

Installers must only fit solar panels if they're sure your roof can hold their weight, and carry on doing so for up to 40 years. Fortunately, most roofs in the UK are built to hold much more than a solar panel system, which usually weigh around 20kg per square metre when everything's included.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

"The solar panels will need to be mounted on the roof by installers who understand roofing and will need some scaffold decks to safely get the panels to the roof.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
